B-1:5-2:2 - Message Proclaimed: God is Light

C – 2:3-17 – Abiding in Him; Perfected in Love

D-2:18-27 – You have an anointing from the Holy One

E - 2:28-3:10 – Confidence at His appearing

F - 3:11-18 - Eternal Life expressed through love in deed and truth (vs. 14)

E' - 3:19-24 – Confidence in the Present

D' - 4:1-6 – You are from God

C' - 4:7-5:5 – Abiding in God; Perfected in Love

B' - 5:6-11 – The Spirit Testified: Eternal Life is in the Son

A' - 5:12-21 - Conclusion-Eternal Life has come; We are in Him who is true: Jesus Christ

I also spent some time filling in some of the parallelism within each corresponding section (A-A', B-B', etc.). The "this is the message" formula generally followed the above chiasm: (1:5) - B, (3:11) F, (5:11) B'.

And... in case you're wondering about the scholarship behind the chiasm...here is John Christopher Thomas' chiasm as it appeared in Novum Testamentum XL-4, "The Literary Structure of 1 John":

A – 1:1-4 – Prologue-Eternal Life
