- 1:1-11 Introduction of the three main topics:
 - 1) Faith applied to Trials: humbly submit to God=s good purposes for you
 - 2) Faith applied to Wisdom: humbly seek God=s good will for you
 - 3) Faith applied to Relationships: humbly accept God=s good role for you

THOSE WITH TRUE FAITH IN JESUS WILL HUMBLY:

1:12-18	Trials I: admit responsibility for sin and give thanks for God=s good gifts
1:19-26	Wisdom I: be quick to listen and serve but be slow to speak and get angry
1:27-2:13	Relationships I: give no favoritism to the rich but be merciful to the needy
2:14-26	Trials II: show that we trust God by our actions, not just our proclamations
3:1-18	Wisdom II: speak and live with a gentleness which sows peace instead of disorder
4:1-12	Relationships II: draw near to God with repentance rather than to the world with quarrels
4:13-5:11 Lord	Trials III: place no trust in man=s plans, riches or revenge but await the coming of the
5:12-18	Wisdom III: go to the elders and one another for confession, prayer, healing and assurance
5:19-20	Relationships III: watch out for one another in case any of us stray from the truth
